HRTV to Provide Coverage for Penn Mile and Fabulous Strike Days

Grantville, PA (Thursday, February 28, 2013) – Hollywood Casino at Penn National Race Course has announced a partnership with HRTV, The Network for Horse Sports, to provide race day coverage of the inaugural \$500,000 Penn Mile on June 1 and the \$250,000 Fabulous Strike on Thanksgiving Eve, November 27.

HRTV's coverage will include in-studio commentary and analysis by network talent on Penn National's two big stakes days, in addition to TV and online features and promotion during the week leading up to the events.

"We are thrilled to partner with HRTV and greatly enhance the level of coverage for our major stakes days this year," said Dan Silver, director of racing operations at Hollywood Casino at Penn National Race Course. "The stellar studio and online coverage they provide will help create a real buzz around the Penn Mile, the richest race to be run in the 40-year history of our track, and the Thanksgiving Eve card, which is fast becoming a Penn National tradition."

"HRTV is delighted to enter into a partnership with Penn National for its two major racing days," said Scott Daruty, President of HRTV. "These stakes races are exciting additions to the racing calendar and we're proud to devote comprehensive coverage for each of these great cards."

The brand new \$500,000 Penn Mile, for 3-year-olds on the turf, anchors a June 1 card that will also feature the \$250,000 Mountainview Handicap for 3-year-olds & up going 1 1/8 miles on the main track and the \$150,000 Pennsylvania Governor's Cup for 3-year-olds & up going five furlongs on the turf.

The second running of the \$250,000 Fabulous Strike Handicap for 3-year-olds & up going six furlongs will be contested on Thanksgiving Eve, Wednesday, November 27. Also scheduled for the robust November 27 card will be the \$150,000 Swatara for 3-year-olds and up going 1 1/16 miles and the inaugural running of the \$150,000 Lady in Waiting for fillies and mares going six furlongs.

Post time for both days will be 6 p.m. Eastern.
