ROULETTE

Roulette is pure excitement all the way around.

Here's a quick look at how to get the ball rolling on a great time.

Object of the Game

You're wagering that a ball spun around the track of the Roulette wheel will come to rest on a number, combination of numbers, or colors of your choice.

How To Play

- To begin, players place their bets by setting chips directly on the numbered table layout. The dealer then spins the ball in the opposite direction of the spinning wheel. The ball must complete at least four revolutions to be considered valid.
- Bets are accepted up to the point the dealer announces
 "No more bets."
- When the ball comes to a rest, the dealer pays winning bets accordingly.
- Chips are purchased from the dealer, in denominations of \$1, \$5, \$25, and \$100. You play with your own distinct colored chips that are good only at the table where they're issued.
- Before leaving the table, be sure to cash in your Roulette chips for value chips; Roulette chips have no value printed on them and cannot be used or exchanged anywhere in the casino except at the table where they were purchased.



Roulette Bets & Odds

Bets can be placed in many different ways, and on a variety of numbers.

0 OR 00 BETS pay 35 to 1.

TOP LINE BETS placed on this corner cover the top five numbers (0, 00, 1, 2, 3). Pays 6 to 1.

TWO NUMBER SPLIT BETS
Chips are placed on the line
between any two numbers.
Either number pays 17 to 1.

STRAIGHT UP BETS
Bet on any single number 1
through 36. Pays 35 to 1.

DOZEN OR SECTION BETS cover any number from 1 through 12; 13 through 24; or 25 through 36. Pays 2 to 1.

EVEN MONEY BETS cover red or black; odd or even; 1 through 18; or 19 through 36.

COURTESY LINE for 0 and 00 split.

LINE BETS pay on any chosen group of six numbers across. Pays 5 to 1.

STREET BETS

Place your bet on the line to the left of any row of three numbers. Any of these numbers pays 11 to 1.

the numbers in any column.
A winner on any of the 12 numbers in a chosen column pays 2 to 1.



CORNER BETS

Place your bet at the intersection of any four numbers. Any of the four numbers pays 8 to 1.
